Free elections for German independence



Europe Pre WWII



May 8 1945 — V-E Day (Victory in Europe Day)

- Germany unconditionally surrenders.
- May 30, 1945: Hitler commits suicide.

#2: The Potsdam Proclamation, July 26

 England and America ask for the "unconditional surrender of all Japanese armed forces" and warned: "The alternative for Japan is prompt and utter destruction."
